Description

This olive is a variety native to the village of Santulhão, in the north-east of Trás-os-Montes, and is planted in neighboring villages in the municipalities of Vimioso, Macedo de Cavaleiros and Bragança. The name derives from the patron saint of the land, São Julião, but with time and linguistic corruption, it degenerated into Santulam, Santulhaao, Santulhame and finally Santulhão. It's pure liquid Oiro, which "none of our team can do without on Christmas Eve, so we wanted to share it with all the fans of our wines: here's the first Extra Virgin Olive Oil from Quinta do Monte d'Oiro!
